The end of the 2018-19 seasons finished at Sandown on 27th April, where Team Hobbs finished with 106 winners and total owners prize money of £1,305,374. The season before as you all well know, was testing with just 63 winners overall.

The highlight of last season was to see the little pocket rocket Defi Du Seuil back at the top of his game. He won a competitive novice chase at Exeter in December beating Top of the game (winner of the RSA Novices chase at the Cheltenham festival). He then went onto win the Grade 1 Scilly Isles Novices chase at Sandown in February beating his old rival Lost in Translation. The aim was then the JLT Novices chase at Cheltenham on the Thursday, where Barry Geraghty gave him a fantastic ride to win by 2 ½ lengths. The aim for this season is to keep him fit, healthy, sound and hopefully aim at Cheltenham again in March.

The horses are all looking well from their summer holidays and the majority started back in training on July 8th. We look forward to the 2019-20 season with winners already on the board and look forward to seeing the horses running again this autumn.

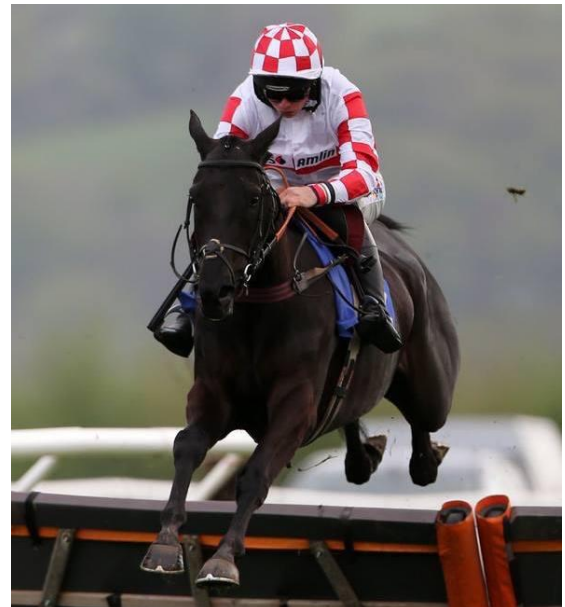
