The yard where the horses congregate every morning has had new tarmac laid and the Woodchip Gallop has been well topped up.

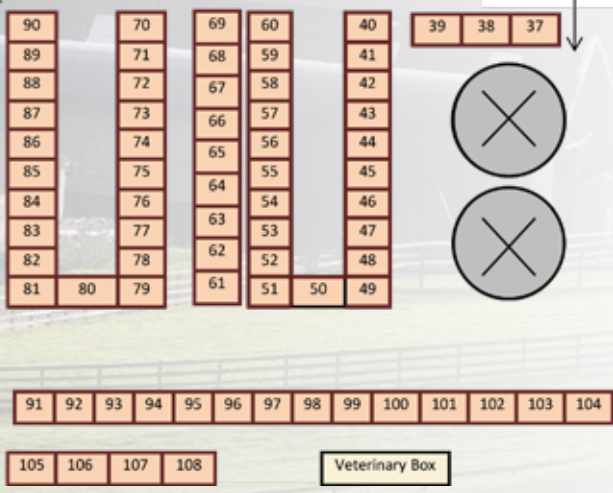
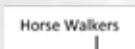
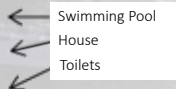
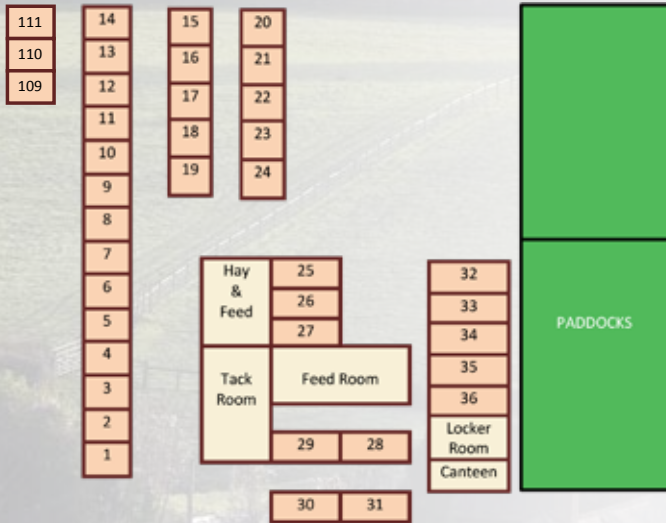

Our first jockey, who has now ridden over 1000 winners. He is very experienced, talented and a reliable member of the team.



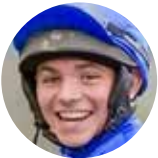
MICHAEL NOLAN

He needs everything to go right – his ideal scenario is a small field and soft ground, plus he likes Sandown.
